Objective(s):

- T.S.W. – Explore and research a “cause” of importance to a chosen audience.
- T.S.W. – Collaborate to explore recycled materials and how they can be used to create art.
- T.S.W. - Demonstrate knowledge of assemblage techniques to create a 3-dimensional sculpture.
- T.S.W. – Demonstrate knowledge of the language of art (Elements of Art and Principles of Design).
- T.S.W. – Present the importance of their cause and creation to an audience (technology can be used).
- T.S.W. – Self assess and critique the work of others using description, analysis, interpretation, and judgment.

Procedures:

1. As a group decide on a “cause.”
2. As a group (partners) create a construction plan. Think about materials, size, how to assemble etc.
3. Gather materials.
4. Begin to construct base structure and overall form.
5. Add materials to create details, texture, and color.

Grading Criteria:

- Sculpture must accurately resemble chosen subject.
- Students may not alter the colors in any way using materials OTHER THAN trash or recycled objects.
- Sculpture must be 3-dimensional and stand-alone without support.
